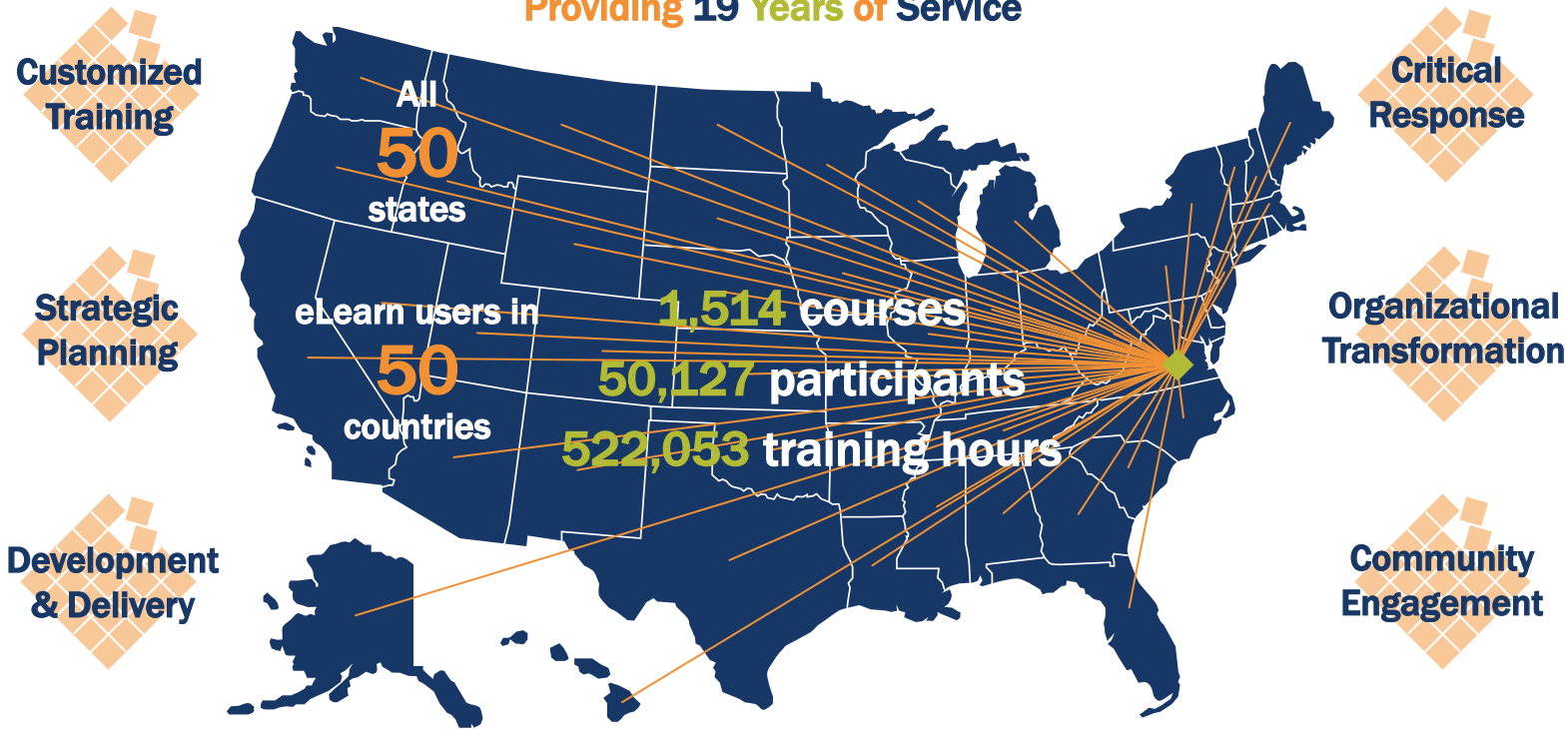

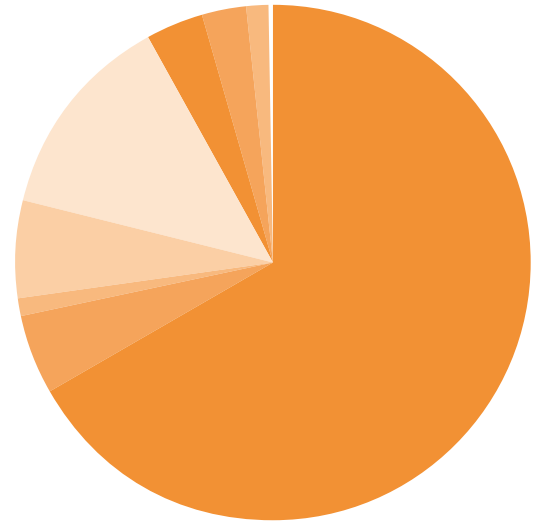

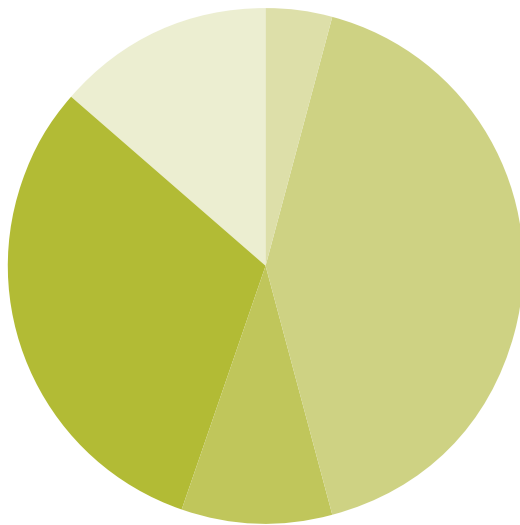
## Revenue
